## Ordinance No. 2024-

## An Ordinance amending section 925.085 of the Minnetonka City Code; relating to dogs at large

The City of Minnetonka Ordains:

Section 1. Section 925.005, subdivision 14 of the Minnetonka City Code, relating to definitions, is amended to read as follows:

14. "Under restraint" regarding a dog <u>has the meaning specified in sections 925.085</u> or 925.105 of this code, as applicable.means being: (a) at heel beside a personhaving custody of it and obedient to that person's command; (b) within a privatemotor vehicle of a person owing, harboring or keeping the animal; or (c)controlled by a leash not exceeding six feet in length.

Section 2. Section 925.085, subdivision 1 of the Minnetonka City Code, relating to animal regulations, is amended to read as follows:

- An owner <u>or caretaker of a dog</u> must not cause or permit <u>the his/her</u> dog to run at large within the city limits, <u>including within a public park</u>, except as <u>otherwise</u> allowed by <u>section 1135.020 of</u> this code. <u>A dog is Being</u> "at large" <u>if it is means being</u> off the property of the person owning, harboring or keeping the dog <u>and not under restraint</u>. <u>A dog is under restraint if it is and not</u>:
  - <u>a.</u> (a) at heel beside a person having custody of it and obedient to that person's command; (b) within a <u>crate</u>, private motor vehicle <u>or other container from</u> which the dog cannot escape of a person owning, harboring or keeping the animal; or <u>.</u>
  - <u>b.</u> (c) <u>effectively restrained controlled</u> by a leash not exceeding six feet in length; a retractable leash not exceeding 20 feet in length may be used to restrain a dog, provided that the leash must be shortened to six feet whenever another person or animal is within 20 feet. For purposes of clause (a) of thissubdivision, the person must be able to demonstrate that the dog will respond to the person's voice or nonverbal command on the first command given.

The provisions of this subdivision do not apply to animals under the command of a law enforcement officer in the performance of official duties.

Section 2. A violation of this ordinance is subject to the penalties and provisions of Chapter XIII of the city code.

Section 3. This ordinance is effective Jan. 1, 2025.
