Proposed improvements include the replacement of three bridges, utility improvements and storm sewer improvements.

Projects of this nature can be disruptive. Proposed impacts may include limited and alternative access to businesses, temporary water service interruptions and tree removal. The city will work to minimize these impacts as much as possible as plans are finalized.
