The City of Minnetonka is replacing three bridges in the Opus Area in 2022 and 2023. This project is a continuation of an ongoing project throughout the Opus Area, which included the replacement of four bridges in 2021. See the reverse side for a map of the proposed project area.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

During construction, roads will be closed at the bridge locations. Residential and business access will be maintained at all times. Maps showing detailed traffic access for each bridge area will be posted on the project website (minnetonkamn.gov/opus-bridges) prior to the start of construction.

Please follow construction signs, watch for traffic pattern changes and drive carefully through construction areas.


PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction will occur in two areas in 2022 and is expected from May to November. Construction of the last and eastern-most bridge on Bren Road East will occur in 2023. The schedule is weather-dependent and subject to change. Tentative construction start dates are as follows:

- Bren Road West Week of May 16, 2022
- Bren Road East (south bridge) Week of June 6, 2022
- Bren Road East (east bridge) Spring 2023




Opus Area Bridge Improvements - Phase III
