The West Metro Police Cadet program is a multi-agency initiative assisting individuals interested in law enforcement with tuition assistance and paid learning opportunities.

HOW IT WORKS

- Candidates apply for the program through a participating police department. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis as space is available.
- Once accepted, police cadets receive tuition assistance to complete their law enforcement degree and become POST eligible.
- During the two years, cadets work part-time in a uniformed position gaining valuable police experience, mentorship and training.
- After completion of the program, cadets are eligible for hire as a full-time police officer.

QUALIFICATIONS

- 18 years or older
- Valid driver's license
- Enrolled or accepted into a two-year law enforcement program within six months of program admittance
- Successful completion of a background check
