The Days of Remembrance April 16-23, 2023

Observed every year in April or May, the Days of Remembrance is a weeklong commemoration of the Holocaust, the state-sponsored persecution and murder of 6 million Jews by the Nazis during WWII. The City of Minnetonka along with the Jewish Community Relations Council presents this free, three-part series to educate and inform. Registration is required for these free programs.

Part 1: A Holocaust Story

Ben Weisner was born in a small town in Romania and survived the Holocaust. Weisner and his parents lived a block from Nobel Peace Prize winner, Elie Wiesel, who brought those stories of survival to the forefront. They immigrated to the United States after World War II. Weisner, who now lives in St. Louis Park, shares this incredible story in person.


