
An Ordinance relating to possession of catalytic converters; repealing section 1045.060 of the Minnetonka City Code

Section 1. The Minnetonka City Code is amended by repealing section 1045.060, a copy of which is attached to this ordinance.


Section 2. This ordinance is effective 30 days after publication.

Exhibit A

1045.060. Unauthorized possession of catalytic converter.

1. Prohibition; exception. It is unlawful for a person to possess a catalytic converter that is not attached to a motor vehicle unless:

- a. the person can provide proof or verification of legal receipt of the catalytic converter; or
- b. the person can provide proof of compliance with the recording requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 325E.21.

2. Penalty. Violation of this section is punishable as a misdemeanor.
