Acknowledgment

By applying for a demolition permit, you acknowledge that the information submitted is complete and accurate; that the work will be in conformance with the ordinances and codes of the city of Minnetonka and with the Minnesota State Building Codes; that you understand this is not a permit but only an application for a permit and work is not to start without a permit; that the work will be in accordance with the approved plan in the case of all work which requires review and approval of plans.

The \$2,000 deposit will be returned only upon compliance with the following requirements:

- 1. Open and unattended foundations must be secured.
- 2. The foundation must be fenced or secured in some other manner within two hours after the building has been removed to prevent uninvited access, particularly by children, to the open foundation.
- 3. Rubbish or other materials must be removed. The site must not be left in an unsafe, unsanitary, or unsightly condition.
- 4. The foundation must not remain open longer than seven days after the building has been removed.
- 5. The foundation must be removed within seven days after the building has been removed and the cavity filled with appropriate earth materials that are graded level with the adjacent areas.
- 6. A site inspection is required before the hole/cavity is filled.
- 7. After the cavity/hole has been filled and the site has been cleaned of all debris, a final site inspection is required.

I have read the ordinance requirements as listed above. I understand that the deposit I submitted will be used to complete the work if the requirements are not met. If a well is located on the property, it must meet MN state statutes: https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/?id=1031
