## Ordinance No. 2024-04

## An Ordinance amending section 325.06(1)(b) of the city's sign regulations; relating to temporary noncommercial signs

The City of Minnetonka Ordains:

Section 1. Section 325.06(1)(b) of the Minnetonka City Code, relating to signs in residential districts, is amended to read as follows:

b) Temporary non-commercial signs, must comply with Table 325.3. Temporary signs may not be illuminated.

<sup>\*</sup> Signs must be located at least five feet from the edge of a public street, must not obstruct driver visibility at intersections and must be placed with the consent of the property owner.

Section 2. This ordinance is effective on the date of its adoption.
