

Ordinance No. 2024-04

An Ordinance amending section 325.06(1)(b) of the city’s sign regulations; relating to temporary noncommercial signs

The City of Minnetonka Ordains:


Section 1. Section 325.06(1)(b) of the Minnetonka City Code, relating to signs in residential districts, is amended to read as follows:

b) Temporary non-commercial signs; must comply with Table 325.3. Temporary signs may not be illuminated.

Table 325.3 Temporary Non-Commercial Signs in Residential Districts					
Property Type	Sign Type	Max. Number of Signs	Max. Area	Max. Height	Duration of Display
Any residential use*/**	Banner or freestanding	3 None	6 sq. ft. per sign 18 sq. ft. aggregate per property None	36	N/A
<p>* Signs must be located at least five feet from the edge of a public street, must not obstruct driver visibility at intersections and must be placed with the consent of the property owner. ** Sign permit not required.</p>					


Section 2. This ordinance is effective on the date of its adoption.
