Ordinance No. 2024-14

An Ordinance relating to veterinary hospital licenses; amending the Minnetonka City Code by repealing section 925.070 and amending section 710.005, paragraph 2

The City of Minnetonka Ordains:

Section 1. Section 925.070 of the Minnetonka City Code, the text of which is set forth below, is repealed in its entirety:

925.070. Veterinary Hospital License.

A veterinary hospital must not operate in the city without a license issued by the police department. The license fee is established in section 710. A license may be issued only after an inspection reveals that the hospital complies with the health and maintenance standards set forth below. A license will be valid for a maximum of one year and will expire on December 31 of each year.
