

## Ordinance No. 2024-19

### An Ordinance relating to use of cannabis, cannabis products, lower-potency hemp edibles, hemp-derived consumer products, and tobacco-related products in specified public places; amending sections 1045 and 1135.020 of the Minnetonka City Code

---

The City of Minnetonka Ordains:

Section 1. Section 1045 of the Minnetonka City Code is amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

1045.032. Cannabis and related products in public places.

1. No use. It is a petty misdemeanor offense for a person to use cannabis flower, cannabis products, lower-potency hemp edibles, or hemp-derived consumer products within 50 feet of any city-maintained outdoor swimming beach, playground, other outdoor facility used for sports or athletics, park shelter, warming house, refreshment stand, or public restroom.
2. No smoking. It is a petty misdemeanor offense for a person to vaporize or smoke cannabis flower, cannabis products, artificially derived cannabinoids or hemp-derived consumer products in any of the following areas:
  - a. on any city park property, including recreational trails located within a park property but not including recreational trails located outside a park property;
  - b. on any part of a property upon which any city-operated building is located.
3. Terms; application. The terms used in this section 1045.032 have the meanings given them in Minnesota Statutes, section 342.01. If a location falls within the provisions of both subdivisions 1 and 2 above, the most restrictive provision shall apply.

Section 2. Section 1135.020, subdivision 18 of the Minnetonka City Code, relating to activities not allowed in city parks, is amended to read as follows:


18. Use of cannabis flower, cannabis products, lower-potency hemp edibles, or hemp-derived consumer products is governed by section 1045.032 of this code. Use of tobacco-related products, as defined at section 625.005 of this code, is prohibited within 50 feet of outdoor swimming beaches, playgrounds, other outdoor facility used for sports or athletics, park shelter, warming house, refreshment stand, or public restroom park areas designated for use by youth, including playgrounds, youth athletic fields, skating rinks, tennis courts, basketball courts, multipurpose courts and informal ball fields.

Section 3. This ordinance is effective 30 days after publication.


