

Only 83 of the 868 MN cities will **not** receive LGA in 2014.




## **External Impacts**

- ✓ Reinstatement of sales tax exemption for most local government purchases in 2014
  - Savings reduces levy increase needed.

✓ Proposed 2.87% city levy increase is below **state levy cap**.


# 2014 Budget – All Funds




