### WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED?

The city proposes to reconstruct Woodhill Road from Excelsior Boulevard to Hwy 7 in order to replace the deteriorating water main system and complete necessary sewer and street improvements. The city also proposes to add a new trail along the west side of Woodhill Road. See the reverse side for details.

### POTENTIAL PROJECT IMPACTS

Please note, construction required for utility replacement projects of this nature can be disruptive. Project impacts include tree removal, driveway reductions, temporary service interruptions, and limited access to homes. The city will review options to minimize these impacts as much as possible as designs are finalized.

### WHAT WILL HAPPEN AT THE MEETING?

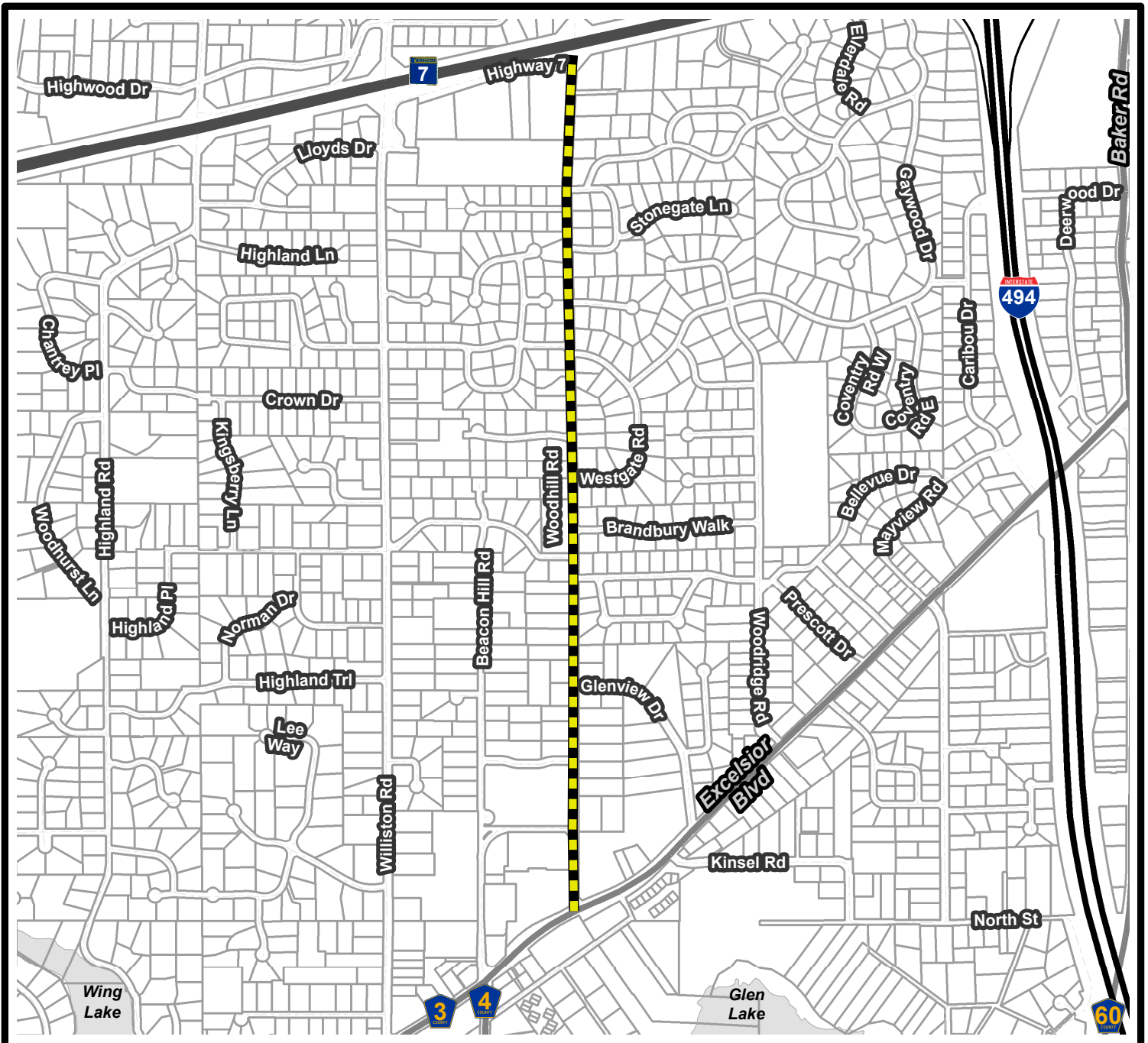

Attendees will learn about the project schedule and communication plan, receive more details about project impacts and have an opportunity to share input, feedback and concerns.

No. These types of improvements are primarily funded through the Street Improvement Fund, funded from general tax levies.

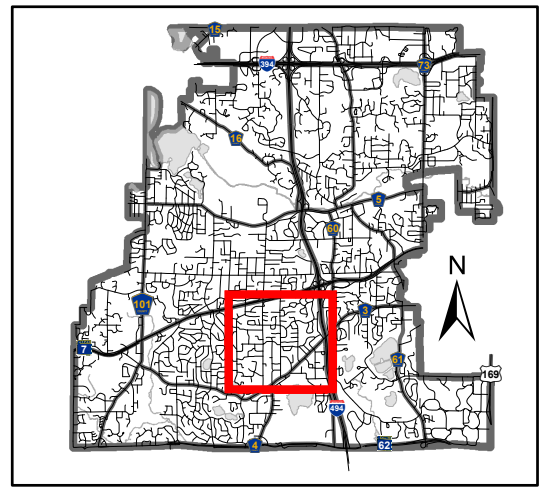
