

Location Map






Future Improvements

 - *Current budget discussions*


Smetana SWLRT Crossing

LRT Roadway Modifications




Future Improvements

Road, bridge and trail improvements

- Bridge replacement 2016 / 2017
 - 10 bridges, primarily in south Opus
 - Includes modifications to Red Circle
- TH 169 repairs (MnDOT) 2016 / 2017
- Opus trail improvements 2018
 - Includes trail lighting and utility repairs
 - Sidewalk installation on Smetana
- Road rehabilitation 2019


Bridge Replacement (red)




Bridge Rendering




Red Circle Changes

Permanent acquisition of right of way

- Acquire as needed
- Easements temporary
 - Acquire as needed
- Acquisition process
 - Adhere to state statutes
 - Those affected will be notified by the city

Bridge Project - Next Steps

- Initial informational meeting: May 12, 2015
- Survey work: May June, 2015

- Develop plans, acquire easements, continue to meet with property owners – October/November 2015 through January 2016
- Begin construction: April 2016
- Complete construction: November 2016
