PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

On 11/11/24 at approximately 1231 hours, I responded to a PD Accident at Yellow Circle Dr/ Red Circle Dr. I met with the parties involved and gathered more information in regard to the incident.

INVOLVED PERSON STATEMENTS

Driver 1 informed me:

He was driving in the left lane, eastbound on Red Circle Dr., south of 10950 Red Circle Drive.

He estimates that he was travelling approximately thirty-five miles per hour (mph).

He believes the vehicle adjacent to him in the right lane was also travelling at 35 mph.

Vehicle 2 attempted to make a left turn into the parking lot to his left, from the right lane and subsequently collided with his vehicle.

The collision caused him to run over a light post located on the north side of Red Circle Dr, southeast of the 10950 Red Circle Dr. building.

He sustained redness and a burning sensation to his left hand after the collision.

He was wearing his seatbelt and not distracted while driving.

Driver 2 informed me:

He was driving in the right lane, eastbound on Red Circle Dr., south of 10950 Red Circle Drive.

He had slowed down to nearly zero when he attempted to make a left turn into the parking garage entrance to the left.

When making the left turn he subsequently collided with the vehicle in the left lane.

He was wearing his seatbelt and not distracted while driving.

He was uninjured as a result of the collision.

Passenger (vehicle 2) informed me:

He was the front passenger in Vehicle 2.

He observed that Vehicle 1 was travelling very fast in the left lane, possibly 45 mph.

He tried to warn Driver 2 about Vehicle 1 by telling him to watch out prior to turning.

Driver 2 was unable to stop turning in time and the vehicles subsequently collided.

He was wearing his seatbelt and uninjured.

OFFICER ACTIONS/ OBSERVATIONS

Upon arrival, I checked for claims of injuries for the parties involved.

Driver 1 stated that he had burning sensation and visible redness to his left hand.

I took photos of Esparza's hand and uploaded it into iCrimeFigther.

Vehicle 1 was on the north side of the road and had damage to its passenger side and front hood.

The light post that was run over was underneath Vehicle 1.

Vehicle 2 had damage to its front driver side and passenger side wheel.

Both vehicles were not drivable, however both parties opted to call their own tow companies.

Both parties exchanged insurance information at the scene.

On 11-12-24 at 0858 hours, I responded to the area of County Road 101 and Highland Ave. for a report of a three-vehicle accident that was not blocking. I arrived at the scene and observed the three vehicles pulled to the side and not blocking the northbound traffic. I made contact with the involved parties and confirmed that paramedics and/or Fire was not needed at the scene. Driver 1 stated that she was traveling northbound on County 101 when traffic in front of her slowed to a stop but she did not realize it and struck the rear-end of Vehicle 2. Driver 1 claims she was not on her cellphone or otherwise distracted. Due to the action of Vehicle 1, Vehicle 2 was pushed into Vehicle 3 that was stopped directly in front of Vehicle 2. Vehicle 1 had moderate front-end damage but was operational and Driver 1 elected to drive it a short distance to her home in Minnetonka. Vehicle 2 sustained moderate damage to the front and rear. Driver 2 decided to order a private tow. Vehicle 2 was left on the shoulder and was not blocking. Driver 2 was picked-up from the scene by a family member. Vehicle 3 had minor rear-end damage and was driven from the scene by Driver 3. There was no suspected alcohol or narcotics use exhibited by any of the involved parties. Parties exchanged information and all were provided a business card with the case number. BWC on.
