Minutes of the November 2019 meeting were approved.

President's Report:

- Elections for SAB officers will be in January. Nominations will be taken from the floor.
- Wendy Woodfill is resigning from the board effective December 31st.

Staff Report:

- Fran will deliver the donated eye glasses to the Lion's Club.
- It will be several more weeks before the window treatments in the Glen Lake Activity Room will be installed, due to back order.

Old Business:

- Dick King reported that the University of Minnesota Master Gardeners are finishing up their series for the Memory Cafes. The MacPhail Center for Music will start its series in January; a movie and discussion program will be offered on April 30th at 1 p.m. The movie will be "A Timeless Love"; with discussion led by Lori LaBey.
- A call for city board membership was advertised in the Memo.
- Changes to the Senior Advisory Board (SAB) bylaws were approved. Mention of the former finance committee was deleted. The role of past president was amended; attendance at executive committee meetings is encouraged for one year, if all three officers are new.
- Volunteers are needed at the Winter Markets.
- Members voted on projects proposed at the November meeting. In order of most votes:

- 5. Re-establish connections with area high schools: 3 votes
- 6. Offer cooking/baking instruction: 3 votes
- 7. Offer tap dance instruction: 1 vote
- 8. Explore transportation options: 1 vote
- 9. Create a list of specialized skills of seniors: 1 vote
