# PROCEDURES AND CHECKLIST FOR NON-PROFIT APPLICANTS SOLICITOR OR CANVASSERS LICENSE

As a means of informing city staff and residents that you requested to be active in the city, the attached Non-Profit Solicitor/Canvasser form provides the city with the information we must have to inform police/residents of your presence within the city. This printed form is considered a convenience for you to answer the necessary questions the city would ask, and also tell you what proof of non-profit, tax-exempt status must be provided.

However, if you want your staff to be issued a <u>license</u> and <u>photo identification badge</u>, each person must complete a <u>For-Profit</u> Peddler, Solicitor, or Canvasser application, as we do not issue a license/badge these without a background check on each person. There is no charge to you for this.

Steps for Non-Exempt Solicitor, and Canvassers:

1. Complete the information form:
 Do not leave any lines blank – if question does not apply, write a "N/A". Applicants, by signing, are confirming that all information is current.
2. Attach a copy of a <u>current</u> state or federal letter confirming your tax-exempt status. (This is sent every year to all non-profit organizations stating they have met the yearly requirement).
3. Please include a list of names of solicitors – if needed for police identification.
These above items can be sent back to the city by email, fax, or mail. See the top of this page for that

Keep for your own reference, and to review with your staff, the attached copy of the Minnetonka Code of Ordinances, Section 630 PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS, AND CONVASSERS,

As soon as the returned information is reviewed for completeness, we will notify the Police Department of the information provided. You will also be listed on the city website as a confirmed non-profit solicitor/peddler. You may call the phone number at the top of this page to confirm that we received your information.

### **Minnetonka Code of Ordinances**

#### SECTION 630. PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS, AND CANVASSERS.

#### ONLY APPLICABLE SECTIONS ARE LISTED BELOW:

630.005. Definitions.

6. "Non-profit" means an organization that currently has tax-exempt status from either the state or federal government and provides written evidence of that status.

630.020. Exceptions.

6. soliciting money, donations or financial assistance for a political, religious or non-profit tax-exempt organization, or selling or distributing literature or merchandise for which a fee is charged or solicited on behalf of such an organization.

630.050. Standards of Conduct.

- 5. A person conducting regulated activity must not go onto private property for that purpose when there are signs prominently posted indicating that trespassing and/or solicitation is unwelcome or prohibited.
- 6. A person must not be on a street, highway, or adjacent boulevard and direct regulated activity toward the occupants of any motor vehicle in transit and must not obstruct the free flow of vehicular or pedestrian traffic on any public street, sidewalk, or other public right-of-way.
- 7. A person must not conduct regulated activity in a manner that creates a health or safety hazard.
- 8. A person must conduct regulated activity in a reasonably courteous manner at all times, must not engage in offensive, obscene, or abusive language, must not push open a door not opened by an occupant, must not place any portion of the person's body through an opened doorway without the invitation of an occupant, and must not physically attempt to stop an occupant from closing a door
