WHAT'S BEING PROPOSED

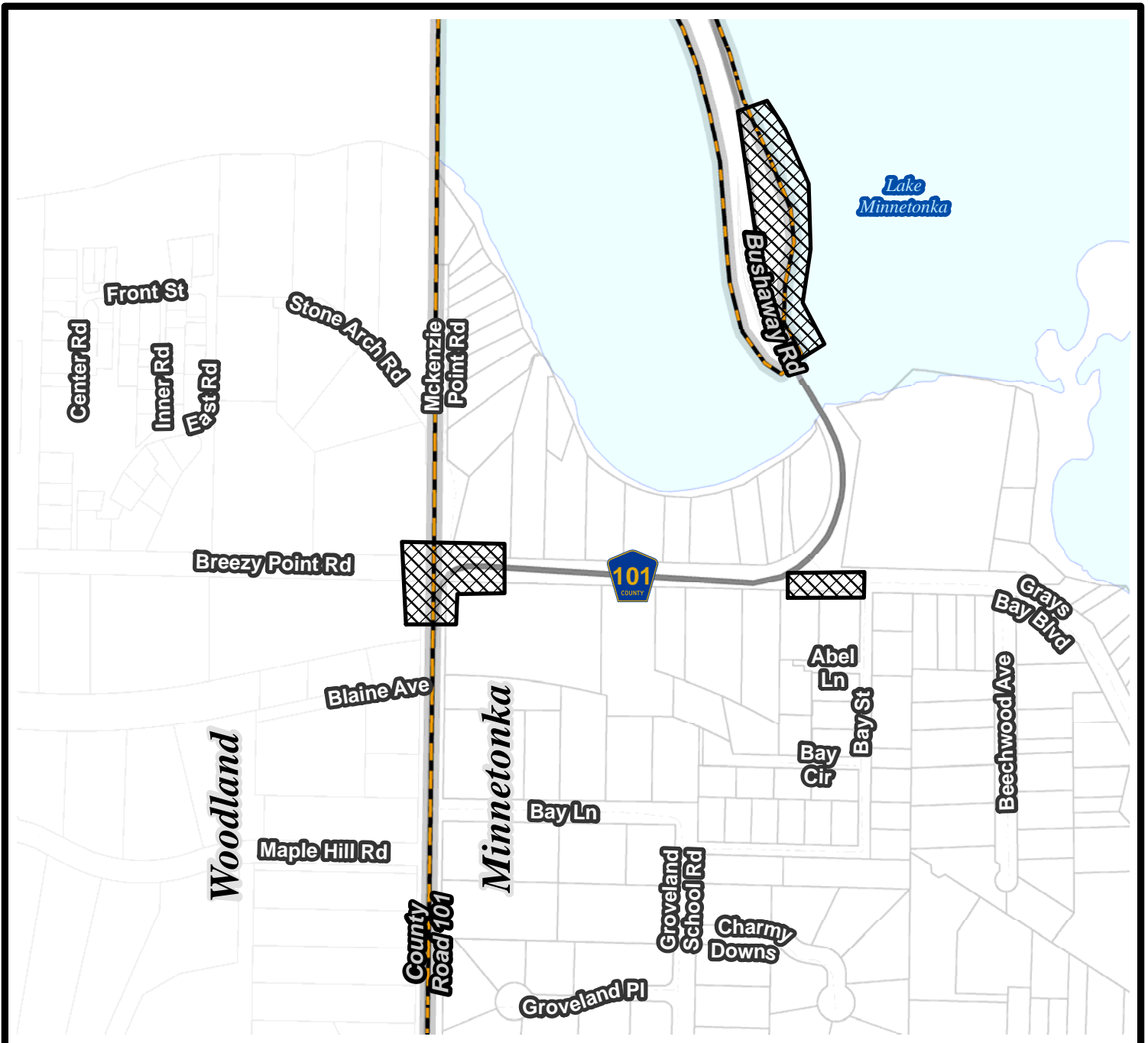

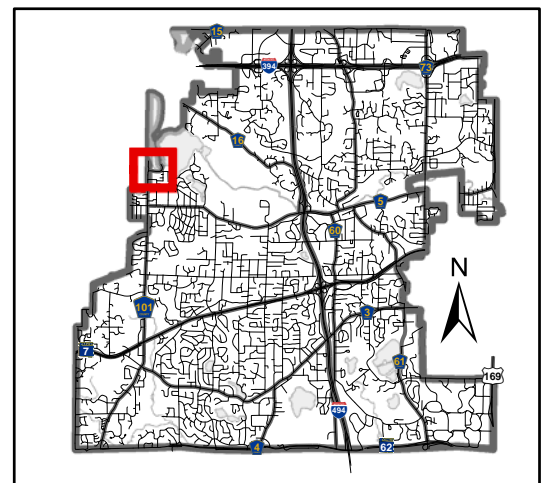
