## Project overview

In 2020, the city will replace three pedestrian bridges in the Opus area. Two are on Red Circle Drive and one is on Bred Road West; see the project map on the reverse side for exact locations.

The project also includes street improvements on Red Circle Drive and utility replacement throughout the project area. Construction will be coordinated with the Southwest Light Rail Transit project.

Seven additional bridges in the area are proposed to be replaced as future stages to reduce traffic impacts.

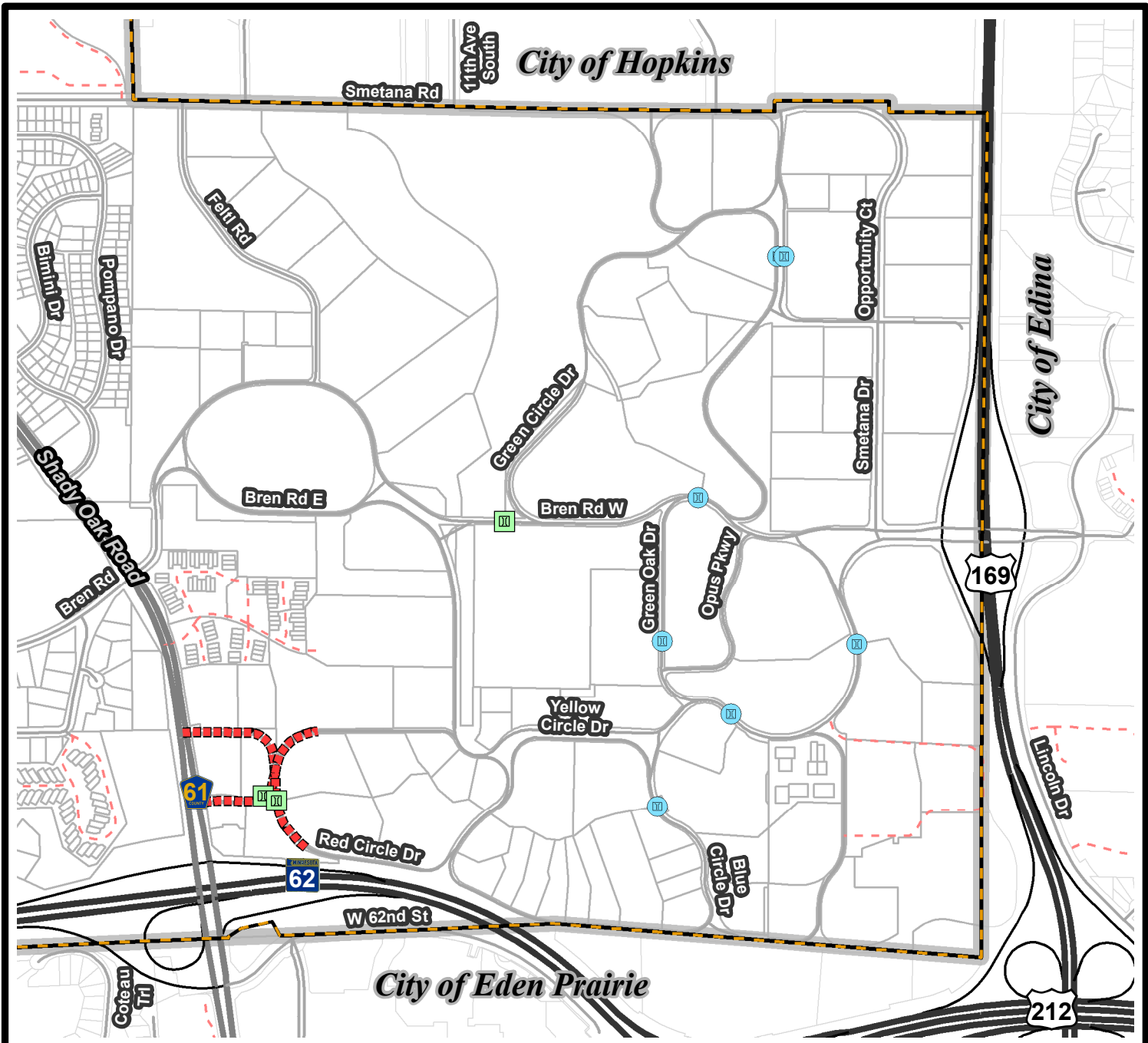
Construction of this nature can be disruptive. Project impacts include temporary service interruptions and access changes to businesses and homes. We will try to minimize impacts as much as possible.

No. These improvements are primarily funded through the Street Improvement Fund, funded by general tax levies.

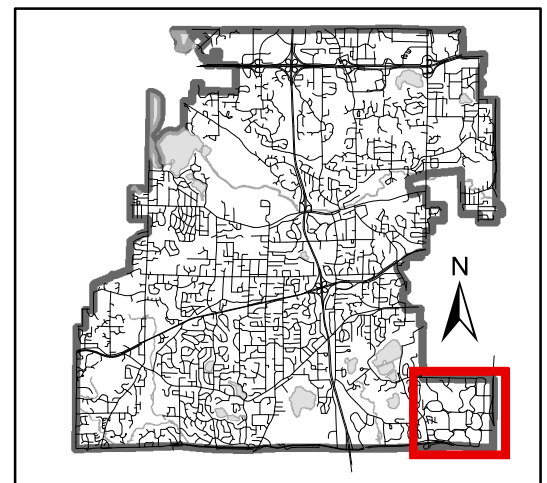
