WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED?

Proposed improvements include the replacement of four bridges, utility improvements and storm sewer improvements.

POTENTIAL PROJECT IMPACTS

Projects of this nature can be disruptive. Proposed impacts may include limited and alternative access to businesses, temporary water service interruptions and tree removal. The city will attempt to minimize these impacts as much as possible as plans are finalized.

IF THIS PROJECT IS APPROVED, WILL I BE ASSESSED?

No. These types of improvements are primarily funded through state bridge funds and the city's Street Improvement Fund.
