POTENTIAL PROJECT IMPACTS

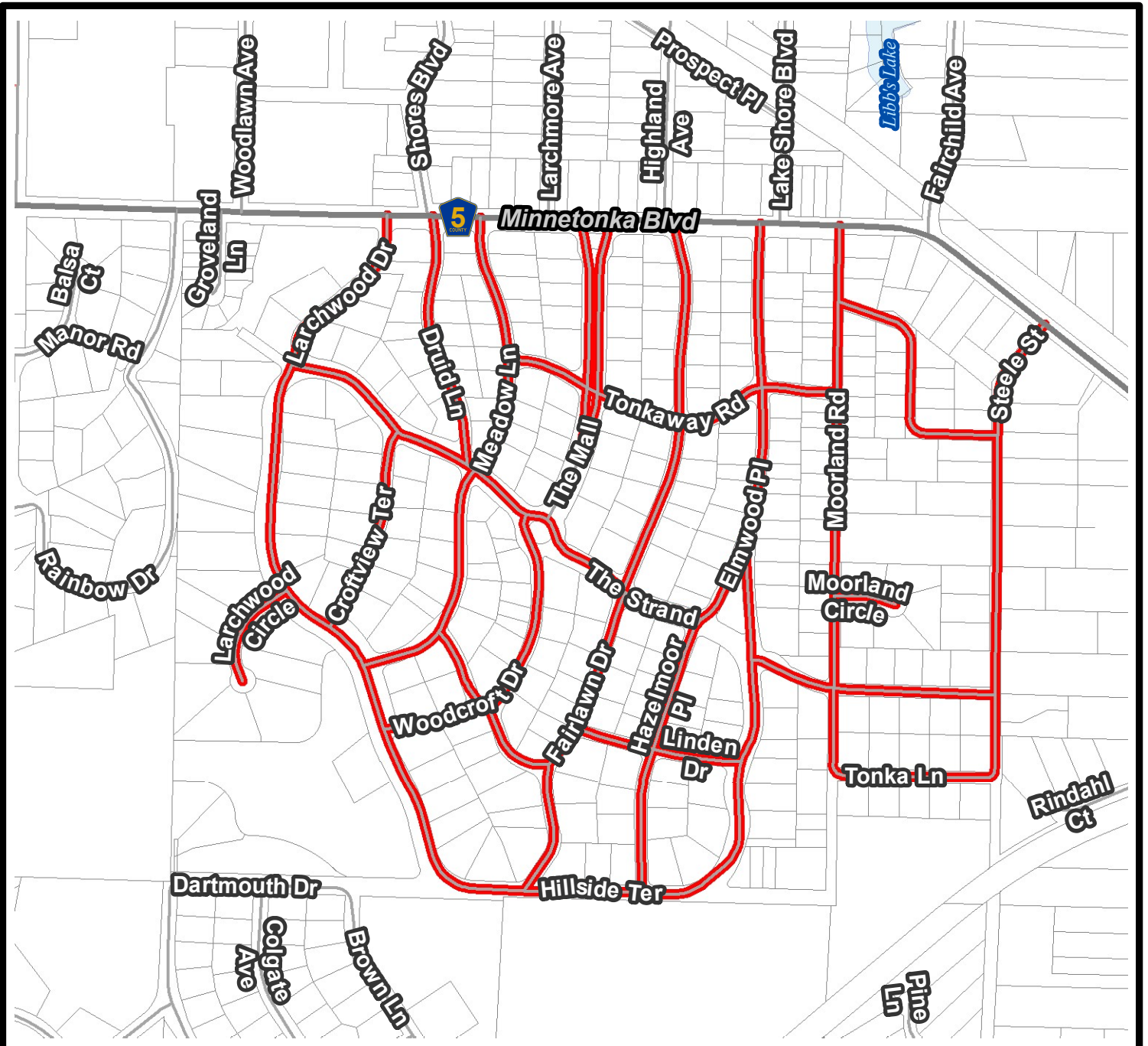

No. These types of improvements are primarily funded through the city's Street Improvement Fund.

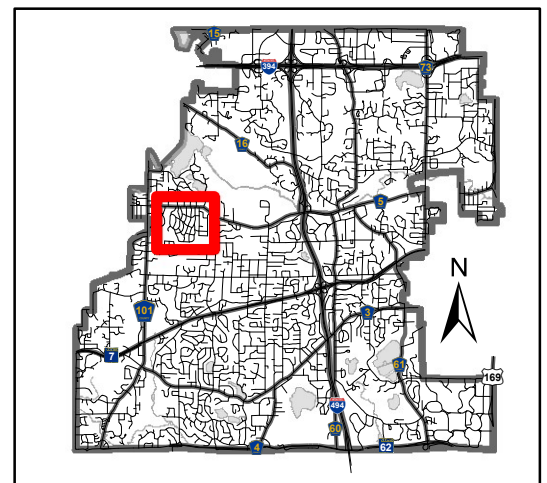
