

Special One-day Community Drop-off Event

Minnetonka residents may drop off the materials listed below.

Appliances

Fee: \$10 each (residential, electric)

Washer, dryer, dishwasher, oven, cooktop, microwave, freezer, refrigerator, water heater, home furnace, trash compactor, garbage disposer, humidifier, dehumidifier, air conditioner, **water softener-\$20**. *Commercial appliances and gas appliances can be dropped off for an additional fee.*

Vehicle Batteries

Free

All 12-volt car or truck batteries are accepted.

Note: Rechargeable batteries (tools, kids cars, etc.) and household batteries (D, C, AA, AAA, 6- and 9-volt cells), and button batteries are **no longer accepted**.

Bicycles

Free

Bicycles brought to the special drop-off will be given a second chance by Re-Cycle (612-876-5356).

Building Materials

Free

Cabinetry, countertops, doors, flooring, lumber, etc. See website for more information.

Carpet and Padding

Fee: \$2/sq. yd. for carpet and \$2/sq. yd. for padding

Roll carpet or pad and tape or tie rolls. Rolls must not exceed six feet in length and/or up to 12 inches in diameter.

Clothing & Linens

Free

Pants, shirts, sweaters, shoes, coats, shorts, jeans, winter wear, hats, t-shirts, belts, jackets, ties, suits, dresses, baby clothing, sheets, bedspreads, quilts, blankets, pillows, curtains

Not Accepted: Underwear, socks,

medical clothing.

Doors

Fee: \$5 and up, depending on size

Electronics - Not Accepted

Fluorescent Lamps

Free

Up to ten fluorescent bulbs are accepted per vehicle. No lamps are accepted from business or commercial use (including apartment buildings). Please don't tape bulbs!

Furniture

Fee: Chairs \$5–small, \$10–large; Loveseat \$15; Couch/sofa \$20; hide-a-bed \$30; sectionals, dressers, chests, tables and other furniture \$5 and up depending on size

Lumber

Fee: \$5 minimum, based on \$25 per cubic yard

No railroad ties, concrete or shingles.

Mattresses and Box Springs

Fee: \$25 per piece for all sizes

Mattresses are dismantled and acceptable materials recycled by nonprofit Second Chance Recycling – a program of EMERGE.

Medical Equipment (good condition)

Free

Wheelchairs, walkers, crutches, canes, etc.

Propane Tanks

Fee: Small: \$1; Large: \$5 (2-lb. or larger)

Scrap Metal

Dirty Scrap Metal fee: \$5

Dirty scrap metal includes: lawn chairs with webbing, barbecues or lawn mower with wheels and/or plastic parts still attached. All

engines must be drained of oil and gas. Additional charges apply for riding mowers, garden tractors, snow blowers, or other large items.

Clean scrap metal: Free

All plastic, rubber, wood, concrete must be removed. Clean scrap metal includes pipe, gutters, swing sets, barbecues, ducting, fencing, shelving, etc.

Tires

Fee: Car, trailer or light truck \$4 each; tires on rim \$8; tractor or truck tire on split rim \$30

Toilets and Non-Metal Sinks

Fee: \$5 each

Windows

Fee: \$5 minimum, based on \$30 per cubic yard

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

Concrete
Construction debris
Electronics
Fire Extinguishers
Hazardous waste
Household batteries
Liquids of any kind
Mercury thermometers
Mercury thermostats
Railroad ties
Rechargeable Batteries
Shingles
Trash
